

# Request for temporary suspension of exclusion



Note: Enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe may request a temporary suspension of their exclusion and enter the non-gaming floor areas of a Gaming Enterprise to exercise their rights to vote, attend tribal political or community meetings, and/or to attend work-related meetings or access job sites. All suspensions of exclusions are subject to approval by the Director of the Office of Gaming Regulation and Compliance (OGR&C) and the Gaming Regulatory Board (GRA). Please do not enter the premises until you have received written notice that your exclusion is suspended or you may be subject to removal. Under no circumstance shall the person on the Exclusion List be permitted to participate in any gaming activity or enter gaming areas unless there is a legitimate work-related reason to do so while on the premises. This suspension may be revoked if you do not follow these directions. See DGR 6 for full details.
