COURT OF CENTRAL JURISDICTION

COURT ORDER NO. 006

In the matter of the review of opinions of the Solicitor General.

The following rules shall apply for the legality review of said opinions.

Rule No. 1

The Solicitor General shall submit to the Chief Justice of the Court a certified copy of all opinions on the same date the opinion was rendered.

Rule No. 2

The Court of Central Jurisdiction shall review all opinions of the Solicitor General during the session of the Court in which said opinion was rendered. Should the Court fail to review any opinion, it shall have the authority to postpone and transfer action until the next session of the Court. No further postponements or transfers can occur without civil litigation being commencement.

Rule No. 3

The Court of Central Jurisdiction shall by majority vote of its justices formally submit any opinion to full legal scrutiny in an en-banc hearing of the Court.

Rule No. 4

The Court of Central Jurisdiction's review of any opinion shall not preclude formal civil litigation by a third party at any future time.

Rule No. 5

The Court of Central Jurisdiction upon majority vote shall hold a hearing to consider the legality of any opinion utilizing the following procedures.

{1} The matter shall be known as:

"In the Matter of the Legality Review of the Opinion of the Solicitor General. Opinion No. _____.

{2} The Solicitor General shall file a written response to Notification of Review for the purpose of defending said Opinion. He shall respond to all questions listed in the notification of review. He shall have five working days to respond to the Court.

{3} Within fifteen {15} days of receipt of the response the Chief Justice shall schedule a hearing on the matter.

{4} The Solicitor General shall have one hour to present his statement. He shall confine his comments to those listed in his written response.


{5} Any justice of the Court may ask any pertinent question regarding the case.

{6} Where applicable, the Court shall abide by Court Order No. 002.

Rule No. 6

In the event of the annulment of any Solicitor General Opinion, the Chief Executive and the Speaker of the Assembly shall be notified by certified copy of the order.
