THE COURT OF CENTRAL JURISDICTION COURT ORDER 004

In the matter of the maintenance of proper Courtroom decorum, exparte.

The following order for the provision of officially sworn law enforcement personnel to be present during all matters before the Court of Central Jurisdiction.

The Chief Natural Resource Officer of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians shall assign himself or any duly sworn Natural Resource or law enfoncement officer to the Count of Central surisdiction with said officer to act as Bailiff of the Count.

The Bailiff shall be in attendance at all sessions of the Court involving criminal or civil matters and serve all process and warrents and perform such other duties as may be directed by the Chief Justice or any justice presiding over any hearing.
