Certificate of Correctness

- WHEREAS, on January 21, 1998, the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Band Assembly ("Band Assembly") approved Ordinance 17-98; WHEREAS, according to 3 MLBS § 17(c), the Chief Executive has five calendar days to either sign the bill into law or veto the bill. according to James Genia, the Solicitor General at the time, the Chief Executive WHEREAS, took no action within the five calendar days, which resulted in Ordinance 17-98 becoming law. on September 14, 2000, the Band Assembly approved Ordinance 29-00, which WHEREAS, amended Section 3 of Title 7 and contained an expiration date of December 31, 2000; on September 19, 2000, the Chief Executive signed into law Ordinance 29-00; WHEREAS, on October 11, 2005, the Band Assembly approved Ordinance 03-06, which WHEREAS, amended Title 7 to more specifically outline the guidelines for bonding requirements of construction projects; WHEREAS, on October 14, 2005, the Chief Executive signed into law Ordinance 03-06; on November 12, 2009, the Band Assembly approved and the Chief Executive WHEREAS, signed into law Ordinance 44-09, which amended 7 MLBS § 26; on January 23, 2014, the Band Assembly approved Ordinance 15-14, which WHEREAS, amended 7 MLBS § 21;
- WHEREAS, on January 27, 2014, the Chief Executive signed into law Ordinance 15-14;
- WHEREAS, on November 12, 2019, the Band Assembly approved Ordinance 09-20, which amended 7 MLBS §§ 10, 16;
- WHEREAS, on November 13, 2019, the Chief Executive signed into law Ordinance 09-20;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 25 MLBS § 15, the Revisor is responsible to publish Band statutes; and
