POLICY STATEMENT:

Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe medical clinics will implement the use of approved protocols to guide the management of clinical situations or processes of care that will apply to most patients.

PURPOSE:

To support practice in the implementation of patient care protocols

PROCEDURE:

1. Protocols will reviewed annually by appropriate stakeholders
2. The most recent HHS protocol template will be utilized
3. Once new, revised or reviewed protocols are approved, they will be dispersed and reviewed with clinical staff.
4. For any patient whose care cannot be managed by standardized protocols because of clinically valid reasons, the provider will document in the EHR why the protocol is not being followed.
