**POLICY STATEMENT:** The Mille Lacs Band Health Services will appoint a RSO (Radiation Safety Officer) who is knowledgeable in the National Council of Radiation Protection policy and guidelines, the Indian Health Services Medical Imaging Program and Minnesota Department of Health rules as they apply to the radiology department. The RSO will spend around 8 hours per week fulfilling their duties.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this policy is to designate a qualified RSO.

**PROCEDURE:** The Executive Director or designee, is responsible for designating the RSO.

## **RSO** Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide leadership in development and implementation of a radiation safety and quality assurance program, reviewed on an annual basis at a minimum.
- 2. Implement written policies and procedures for the radiation safety and quality assurance programs.
- 3. Ensure all x-ray equipment receives proper maintenance, calibration, electrical and mechanical surveys as required and proper corrective action has been taken and documented on all adverse findings.
- 4. Ensure radiology safety and quality assurance initial and annual retraining is provided and documented.
- 5. Review and maintain all radiology policies and procedures.
- 6. Review personnel dosimetry reports and reporting systems.
- 7. Is responsible for the annual evaluation of lead aprons and shields used to protect patients and staff.
