POLICY STATEMENT: All Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Programs participate in the Drug and Alcohol Abuse Normative Evaluation System (DAANES).

PURPOSE: The purpose of this policy is to be in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 254B.05, subdivision 1b. SUD providers must participate in DAANES to be eligible for payment under the Consolidated Chemical Dependency Treatment Fund (CCDTF).

PROCEDURES: The data may be used to assess treatment resource needs and track admission trends by substance of abuse and by demographic. All enrolled alcohol and drug treatment programs in Minnesota need to complete and submit individual client DAANES admission and discharge data. Unless this process is completed treatment funding provided by CCDTF will not be accessible.

The information must include demographic data about the client, including the client's chemical use history, previous treatment services related to chemical use, other problems associated with chemical use, and status at the time of service termination. The license holder must submit additional information requested by the Department of Human Services that is necessary to meet statutory of federal funding requirements.
