POLICY STATEMENT: Mille Lacs Band Four Winds Lodge shall require and maintain a statement that client is free of communicable disease at time of admission, and address any special needs such as diet and medication.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this policy is to verify communication from the LIP to nursing staff related to the care of the Four Winds client.

DEFINITIONS:

<u>Licensed Independent Practitioner</u> (LIP): An LIP is any person in the State of Minnesota who, by reason of training and licensure, may practice independently.

Exam: General medical history and physical examination

PROCEDURES:

- A. If a client is admitting from another facility with a completed physical exam, it needs to have been completed within 30 days prior to Four Winds Lodge admission. A copy of the initial exam needs to be included with any updates.
- B. If an exam has not been provided, the client will receive an exam within 3 days of admission.
- C. If a client refuses an exam, in whole or part, the nursing staff shall document this in the chart. Clients refusing an initial exam will be given a second opportunity to complete an exam on a different day. Any observations that may be used to establish the client's physical condition shall be documented in the chart by an LIP or RN.
- D. If the client has a medical condition thought to be dangerous to self or others, the RN Supervisors or designee will initiate emergency procedures by calling 911, for conducting an involuntary medical evaluation and the situation shall be brought to the attention of the LIP or designee for further direction and consultation.
- E. If a Four Winds client refuses a medical history and physical examination the client will be discharged from the program, if deemed safe to do so.
