- b. In the event that a client’s behavior needs to be managed prior to or during transfer to different environment, staff will use approved verbal negotiating skills and personal safety techniques.
 - c. Emergency procedures do not include seclusion or restraint, are not part of the treatment plan, used to enforce program rules, or for the convenience of staff.
 - d. Emergency procedures are only used in response to specific current behaviors that threaten the safety of the client, others, or property.
7. In the case of a medical emergency, emergency numbers are posted and available to staff. Medical and psychiatric emergencies may be managed through the community emergency medical system. Call 911.
8. If appropriate, an Incident Report is completed and appropriate notifications are made.
